ANOTHER TRANSCRIPT OF THE SERVICE IN HONOUR OF CONSTANTINE-CYRYL  
THE PHILOSOPHER

*(Summary)*

The article poses some fundamental questions concerning one of the earliest original hymnographic works of Old Bulgarian literature. New data on some of the earliest transcripts of the work in Russian manuscripts from the 12th–14th cc. are put forward. The MSS belong to the Central State Archives in Moscow and are part of the collection of the Moscow Synod Printing House. Russian scholars at the end of the 19th and the beginning of the 20th c. were familiar with these transcripts but until recently their whereabouts remained unknown. Their present pressmarks have been established with a high degree of accuracy and the text of one of them is published.
