THE DENOMINATION $\Theta\text{HP}\text{KAN}\text{H}\text{H}\text{A}$ IN SVYATOSLAV IZBORNİK OF 1073

(Summary)

The denominations $\Theta\text{HP}\text{KAN}\text{H}\text{H}\text{A}$ and $\Theta\text{HP}\text{KAN}\text{E}$ in Svyatoslav Izbornik of 1073 on the basis of the denominations Dat. Pl. $\text{παρ}\text{-}\text{φο}\text{μ}\text{ζ}$, $\text{μη}\text{-}\text{δο}\text{μ}\text{ζ}$, $\text{περ}\text{-}\text{ςο}\text{μ}\text{ζ}$, $\text{βα}\text{-}\text{χ}\text{-}\text{ζτο}\text{μ}\text{ζ}$, $\text{μαρ}\text{-}\text{γο}\text{μ}\text{ζ}$ can be connected with the ancient East-Iranian country Ὑρκανία , Hyrcana, Organa. Information on the country Ὑρκανία is provided in the works of Xenophon, Herodotus, Strabo, Plinius Secundus, Claudius Ptolemaeus, in the Old Iranian book Avesta, in the works of the Arab geographers, in the historical chronicles of the medieval missionaries and others. The name Ὁργανῶ in the Greek sources can be explained as eponym (a name Ὁργανᾶ is not found in the List of the Proto-Bulgarian khans). An assumption is made that the name Ὁργανῶ also denotes the country which was ruled by the ruler Ὁργανῶ as Bulgarius in some chronicles is the name of Asparuh, the ruler of Bulgaria.
