HOMILY ON THE EVE OF CANDLEMAS (ACCORDING TO THE SYNAXARIA F.19 № 95 AND 97, KEPT IN THE WRÓBLEWSKI LIBRARY OF THE LITHUANIAN ACADEMY OF SCIENCES) IN THE CONTEXT OF THE LITERARY HERITAGE OF ST. KLIMENT OF OHRID

(Summary)

The Homily on the Eve of Candlemas is attested in the manuscript synaxaria F 19–95 and F 19–97, kept in the Wróblewski Library of the Lithuanian Academy of Sciences (inc.: Δα εστε ΒΈΑΟΥΨΕ ΕΡΑΤΪΕ. Τὰ Β ΟΪΗ ΤΑΝΑ Ε΄ ΠΡΕΠΡΑΖΝΑΣΤΕΟ ΟΡΕΤΕΝΙΆ ΤΝΑ. ΔΑ ΟΒΕΡΕΤΕ CA Β΄ ΤΑΡΚΕΝ ΝΑ ΜΑΤΒΟΥ. CZ ΕΛΓΟΓΟΒΈΒΙΑΝΙΕ Η ΥΤΌΤΟΙΟ. ΓΝΈΒΙ ΠΟΠΡΑΒΙΙΕ...). The sermon was written on the territory of the Great Duchy of Lithuania in the beginning of the 16th century or earlier. The version of the homily preserved in the synaxaria 95 and 97 is being published in the article for the first time. The style of the sermon is characteristic for St. Kliment of Ohrid. The analysis of the text shows that it contains fragments from the sermons on Christmas Eve and on the Eve of Epiphany, both of which are traditionally attributed to St. Kliment of Ohrid. Therefore this

sermon should also be studied in connection with other literary works of St. Kliment of
